## 2024 Square Butte Community Association Chili Cook-off Official Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations are to be adhered to by all cook-off contestants:

The entry fee is \$10.00 per Chili entered. Contestants may enter more than one batch of Chili.

Chili must be delivered to the hall by 4:30 pm to allow for setup. Each contestant will be assigned a "entry number" on the day of the event.

Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Each guest ticket is eligible to cast 1 vote. Chili with highest number of votes will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, second highest vote count will take 2<sup>nd</sup> place and third highest will take 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

Chili Cook-off contestants must supply a 5-quart slow cooker full of chili. A portion will be used for taste-testing and the remainder will be for public consumption as part of this fundraiser.

Chili must be made from scratch and the recipe name along with a complete list of ingredients must be submitted.

Chili must be brought "ready-to-eat". All ingredients must be pre-cooked prior to the event. Chili must be stored in a 5-quart slow cooker to maintain hot temperature. (Food Safe Guidelines)

Contestants must supply any specific condiments they desire for the taste testing along with a serving spoon. Spoons, bowls and napkins for serving the Chili to the general public will be provided.

Each contestant is responsible for cleaning up and removing all their personal items from the area.

Taste-testing / judging will take place from 5-6pm.
